### **Keyboard and Guitar lessons in Term 2**

From next term, we will be welcoming Mr. Chris Costello to our staff team. Mr. Costello will be teaching both keyboard and guitar lessons at school to all K-6 students in small groups of five for 40 minutes each fortnight starting in Week 1. The school will be covering \$50 per child for five music lessons but as the total cost is \$75 we are asking each family to contribute just \$25 per student for the

In addition to these group lessons, Mr. Costello has limited spots available for private lessons to be taught at school during school hours. These lessons are \$25 for 30 minutes of private tuition in either keyboard or guitar. Your child does not need their own instrument at the commencement of these private lessons.
