It is so important for our students to make sure they have maximum sun protection when playing in the sun and all students have been provided with a school hat and a pair of school sunglasses. Research shows clear links that exposure to ultraviolet rays as a child predisposes to developing eye diseases including: cataracts, macular degeneration, pterygium, photokeratitis and skin cancer of the eyelid and eye area.
