LEARNING WITH TECHNOLOGY

This term the students have been having a great time exploring digital technologies in the classroom. This has involved learning about the different parts of a computer, their uses and how to care and maintain the school computers. Over the last two weeks they have learnt how to log in, shut down a computer correctly and how to save their schoolwork to the computer and to their Google classroom. They have also engaged in discussions around the safe use of technology at school and at home and the importance of keeping your password private. Some of the ideas discussed by the students included identifing adverts and pop ups and what to do if they accidently click on them. They have also been learning about how a keyboard is laid out and how to position their hands to type effectively. This is an important skill to learn as it helps them to write with more fluency and less effort. Students have also been using cameras on the Interactive whiteboard to record themselves reading aloud to self-assess their fluency and expression. This is a proven way to help with their speed and efficiency in their reading.

One consistent feature of our weekly Greenday Wednesdays are that the students start the day with a nature walk. We always head out and let the students explore and lead the way around our extensive beautiful school grounds. Students seek out living things they can see and relax listening to the sounds they can hear.
